Historical Note

Mathias Thomas Oppersdorff was born on September 11, 1935 in Boston, Massachusetts, and died on January 26, 2010 in Wakefield, Rhode Island. Oppersdorff was an internationally known photographer and has three published works: Adirondack Faces (1991), People of the Road – The Irish Travellers (1997), and Under the Spell of Arabia (2001). His work focused on documenting the people of different communities and important moments in history. After being employed as a travel photographer for Gourmet Magazine for eighteen years, Oppersdorff retired to Matunuck, Rhode Island. While living in Rhode Island, Oppersdorff exhibited his photographic collections at Hale House, which was previously owned and operated by the South County History Center. The collection was donated to the Center by the estate of Mathias Oppersdorff.

Scope and Content

The Mathias Oppersdorff Collection is composed of three distinct projects: South County Faces, portraits of residents of communities in southern Rhode Island; Stone Walls of South County, landscapes of the bespoke stone walls found in southern Rhode Island and portraits of local stonemasons; and Rhode Island Responds to 9/11, portraits of first responders from Rhode Island who worked during the aftermath of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks on the former World Trade Center buildings in New York City. The collection includes slides, a slide carousel tray, photographic prints, framed prints, negatives, postcards, typed documents, handwritten notes, a compact disc, cassette tapes, a printed canvas, and exhibit labels. The collection is an

accumulation of materials that were created and collected by Mathias Oppersdorff between 1992 and 2010.

The records are arranged in three series by thematic photograph collection, which have been further arranged into subseries by material type. The contents of each series and subseries are arranged in original order; some materials have been taken out of original mixed series order and placed into separate series, but have kept original order within the series.
