Historical Note

Founding

The South County Hospital (now South County Health, as of 2015) was founded in 1919 as the South County Cottage Hospital by Caroline Hazard in a house purchased from Mary Watson at 23 Kenyon Avenue (now 288 Kenyon Avenue, Wakefield, RI 02879). Dr. John Paul Jones was the first head physician to treat patients; his wife, Carolyn Jones, was the head nurse and superintendent. Prior to the hospital's establishment, the closest hospitals where residents of southern Rhode Island could receive treatment were to the north in Providence and to the west New London, CT; otherwise, visiting nurses and house calls made by doctors working in private practice were the primary means of accessing medical care. The hospital was incorporated in 1920 as the South County Hospital Association, and has since operated as a private non-profit institution. The hospital operated out of the house on Kenyon Avenue until December of 1925, at which point operations moved into the newly built hospital building at South County Health's current location at 100 Kenyon Ave. Wakefield, RI 02879. Beginning in the 1950s, the original 1925 hospital building was expanded and renovated numerous times, up until the present day. Major renovations documented in this collection are the Borda Wing, Read Wing, and the Bacon House, originally built as a separate residence for nurses. Part of the land that the hospital now occupies was once the site of the Town Farm, the municipally-run poor farm in South Kingstown.

Administrators

Founding board of trustee members of the South County Hospital Association were: Caroline Hazard (1856 – 1945), Ellen P. Robinson, Herbert J. Wells, Bessie H. Curtiss, Thomas G. Hazard, Jr. (1863 – 1946), Susan Sharp Adams, Theakston de Coppet, and Lulu M. Schlesinger. This collection contains records created by:

Caroline Hazard served as president from 1919 – 1928.

Thomas G. Hazard, Jr. served as Secretary and Treasurer in a dual and then alternating capacity from 1919 – 1938. T.G. Hazard oversaw the fundraising, building, and furnishing planning of the 1925 hospital building and other operations throughout the 1920s.

Maud Denico (1891 – 1984) served as superintendent from the mid-1920s until 1939. Her duties included managing operations and logistics at the hospital, as well as managing the nursing staff. The role of superintendent was an administrative position and typically held by a senior member of the nursing staff until the late 1950s. Shortly after Donald L. Ford was brought on as the superintendent and hospital administrator in 1958, the role was redefined as purely administrative and renamed “Administrator.”

Benjamin R. Sturges (1908 – 1997) joined the Hospital Board and was elected president in 1960. He served on the board through the 1980s, working closely with Donald L. Ford on expansions of the hospital facilities and services.

Volunteer groups

South County Hospital Auxiliary Founded in 1932 in to support hospital needs arising from shortages of supplies and deficits in budget due to the Great Depression. The volunteer organization, still active as of 2020, has held fundraisers, collected supplies, run a coffee shop and gift shop in the hospital, provided the hospital with volunteer service to support the hospital, and funded interior decoration projects. The Auxiliary was alternately called the Women’s Services Committee in the 1950s and 1960s, although membership in the organization both previous to that time and afterward was comprised of men and women volunteers. The president of the Auxiliary attended hospital board meetings in the mid-1900s.

Stamp Project: Another important fundraising project for the hospital from the mid-1940s – 1955 was the Stamp Project, devised and run by Frederick R. Hazard. Hazard wrote a weekly column for a local newspaper describing the project. The project collected unused stamps and sold them in bulk to stamp collectors and dealers. Many volunteers, especially women and youth groups, participated in the project.

Scope and Content

The records of the South County Hospital Collection include log books of pharmacy and patient treatments, newspaper clippings, ephemera associated with volunteer and fundraising events, scrapbooks, newsletters, annual reports, correspondence, directories, calendars, promotional materials, oral histories and interviews, bound volumes containing board meeting minutes, bylaws, and incorporating documents, building and furnishing proposals, plans, and contracts, payment receipts and invoices, building plans and blueprints, securities and trust account statements, stock purchase receipts, hospital statistical reports, black and white and color photography in multiple sizes and formats including slides and polaroids as well as negatives.

The materials fall into four series: general records and materials related to hospital activities; executive/board member/administrative creators and collectors, specifically Treasurer and Board Secretary Thomas G. Hazard, Board President Caroline Hazard, Superintendent Maud Denico (and successive superintended, unnamed), and Benjamin R. Sturges; Auxiliary members (operating under the titles “Hospital Auxiliary” and “Women’s Service;” various creators/collectors); and photography (various creators/collectors).
